Governor Musgrove Names Andrew K. Howorth To Circuit Court Bench

Jackson, MS – Governor Ronnie Musgrove has appointed Andrew K. Howorth as Circuit Court Judge for the Third Circuit Court District. Howorth, of Oxford, replaces Robert Kenneth Coleman, who resigned October 16, 2001. Musgrove made the appointment on Wednesday, December 12, 2001.

“Andrew Howorth has a great deal of experience with the court, and that experience will be put to use from the bench,” Musgrove said. “He will be a good and fair judge in the cases brought before him.”

Howorth received his bachelor’s degree from the University of Mississippi in 1984, and his law degree from the University of Mississippi School of Law in 1987. He has worked in private practice with the firm of Howorth O’Donnell Walsh, PLLC. Howorth served as President of the Lafayette County Bar Association from 1990-91, and as Commissioner of the Mississippi Bar Association from 1992-94.
