Governor Musgrove Announces Plans for September 11 Observance

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove will host an observance of the one-year anniversary of the terrorist attacks in New York, Washington and Pennsylvania on Wednesday, September 11, at 1:30 p.m. All Mississippians are invited to attend the observance. The ceremony will take place at the Veterans Memorial in front of the Woolfolk State Office Building, 501 North West Street.

“Every Mississippian was affected by the events of September 11, and it is important for us, as a community of people, to remember and reflect on the impact that day has had on our lives,” Musgrove said. “This will be an opportunity for us to join together to mourn, to remember and to renew our hope for the future.”

Joining Musgrove will be statewide elected officials, members of the Legislature, local officials, representatives of police and fire departments from around the state, active-duty members of the military, and members of the National Guard. The 41st Army Band of the Mississippi National Guard will perform.
