Governor Musgrove Reappoints Barney Schoby To Mississippi Workmen's Compensation Commission

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove has reappointed Barney Schoby of Natchez to another six-year term on the Mississippi Workmen's Compensation Commission. Schoby's term as a representative of employees will run from January 1, 2003, to December 31, 2008.

“Barney Schoby has served the Commission well since 1997, and I appreciate his continued service for another term,” Musgrove said. “The important work of the Commission will be strengthened by his presence.”

Schoby served as an Adams County Supervisor from 1974-1980, and as a member of the Mississippi House of Representatives from 1980-1997. A native of Amite County, Schoby graduated from Alcorn State University. He received a masters in education and worked as a public school teacher in Mississippi and Louisiana from 1964-1970.
