A Proclamation By Governor Ronnie Musgrove

WHEREAS, Jefferson Davis Memorial Highway is a coast-to-coast highway authorized by Congress in 1913; and

WHEREAS, in maintaining this highway, the United Daughters of the Confederacy are preserving their history for the benefit of generations to come; and

WHEREAS, there are currently eleven markers placed along the Jefferson Davis Memorial Highway in the State of Mississippi; and

WHEREAS, the newest addition to the Jefferson Davis Memorial Highway Markers will be dedicated on June 14, 2002, in celebration of this historical highway:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ronnie Musgrove, Governor of the State of Mississippi, hereby proclaim June 15, 2002, as

JEFFERSON DAVIS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY DAY

in the State of Mississippi.
