## **Governor Musgrove Appoints Frank Melton as Director of Bureau of Narcotics**

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove today appointed Frank Melton as director of the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics.

“The Bureau needs a director who will see the Bureau not for what it is, but for what it can become, and that person is Frank Melton,” Musgrove said. “He has the management experience and the leadership capabilities needed at the Bureau, and I am confident he will take on this position with respect for its officers and a commitment to stepping up the fight against drugs in our state.”

Melton is a graduate of Stephen F. Austin State University. He currently serves as chairman and chief executive officer of the TV-3, Inc., Foundation in Jackson, MS. He has been appointed by three Mississippi governors to state boards and commissions.
