Governor Musgrove Announces Passage of Nissan Expansion Package

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove announced the passage of an economic development package in support of the expansion of the Nissan facility in Canton, Mississippi. Musgrove discussed the package at a press conference at the State Capitol.

“For too long, the world has looked at Mississippi and shaken its head. Today, the world looks at Mississippi and sees a dynamic, forward-thinking, innovative place to do business,” Musgrove said. “That’s good for the people of Mississippi.”

The \$68 million incentive package includes \$12 million for construction; \$10 million for a vehicle preparation facility; \$22.5 million for infrastructure including water, sewer and roads; and \$23.5 million for workforce training.

“The expansion package passed today builds on the good work we did with the Advantage Mississippi Initiative on the initial package for Nissan,” said Musgrove. “I want to thank the Lieutenant Governor and the Speaker for their leadership on this matter, as well as the members of the House and Senate for their support.”
