Governor Musgrove Attending Annual Conference of Southern Growth Policies Board

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove is attending the 30th Annual Conference of the Southern Growth Policies Board (SGPB) in Hilton Head, South Carolina. The work of the SGPB focuses on the economic development of its 13 members states and Puerto Rico.

The conference agenda centers on “Human Capital Strategies for the Next Economy,” and how states can connect their workforces with economic development policy.

On Sunday, June 9, Musgrove was part of a panel presenting the “2002 Report on the Future of the South,” along with South Carolina Governor Jim Hodges, West Virginia Governor Bob Wise and SGPB Executive Director Jim Clinton.

Musgrove is Chairman-elect of the SGPB, and Chairman of the Southern Technology Council (STC), which serves as an advisory board to the SGPB and as a resource for developing technology-driven economic development policies.
