## Governor Musgrove Appoints Dr. David C. Newell to the Mississippi State Board of Veterinary Medicine

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove has appointed Dr. David C. Newell of Meridian to the Mississippi State Board of Veterinary Medicine. He will be representing the First Supreme Court District for a five-year term ending May 22, 2008.
