Governor Musgrove Appoints Jon Mark Weathers as District Attorney to 12th Judicial District

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove has appointed Jon Mark Weathers as District Attorney for the 12th Judicial District, effective July 1, 2003. Weathers will fill the vacancy left by the resignation of Lindsay Carter.

“It is vitally important that our war on crime continue without interruption, and Mr. Weathers is well-acquainted with the needs and operations of the 12th District,” Musgrove said. “I appreciate his willingness to immediately step into this position.”

Weathers was campaigning for the position of District Attorney at the time of Carter’s resignation.

Weathers earned degrees at Pearl River Community College and the University of Southern Mississippi before receiving his law degree from the University of Mississippi in 1972. He served as District Attorney for the 12th District from 1976 to 1979. He is a member of the Mississippi State Bar, the South Central Mississippi Bar Association, and the American Trial Lawyers Association. He is also a Fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers and an Advocate in the American Board of Trial Lawyers.

Weathers is married and has two children and two grandchildren.
