Governor Musgrove Names Webb Lee to Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks Commission

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove has appointed Webb Lee of Biloxi to the Mississippi Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks Commission for a five-year term beginning July 1, 2003.

“Webb Lee has spent his entire life on the Mississippi Gulf Coast, and is extremely knowledgeable about issues of importance to the Commission and those it serves,” Musgrove said. “I appreciate his willingness to use that knowledge and experience to strengthen Mississippi’s natural resources.”

Lee served as circuit clerk of Harrison County from 1964 to 1991, and was among the first of seven appointed commissioners to the Mississippi Commission on Marine Resources, serving from 1994 to 1998.
