Governor Musgrove Awards \$394,217 Grant to City of Senatobia

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove has awarded a \$394,217 Economic Development Grant to the City of Senatobia. The funds were awarded on behalf of Aluminum Extrusions, Inc. and will be used to build a new access road, drainage improvements, and to construct an 8 inch water line to provide fire protection.

“Mississippi has a wealth of resources to offer existing businesses and new industries,” said Musgrove. “Economic development grants are just one of the ways we continue to support our communities.”

The funds are administered by the Mississippi Development Authority (MDA) through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program.

“The CDBG program enriches the partnership between the state and the communities that are striving to create opportunities for business and industrial development,” said Steve Hale, Executive Director of Mississippi Development Authority.

CDBG is a program of the Community Services Division of the Mississippi Development Authority. Among the division’s goals are assisting communities in analyzing their strengths and weaknesses, involving their leadership in economic development, planning development strategies, strengthening development organizations, and implementing and financing community projects. The Community Services Division also administers other Economic Development grant and loan programs.
