Governor Musgrove Awards \$74,966 Grant to Town of Pace

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove has awarded a \$74,966 Emergency Public Facilities Grant to the Town of Pace for the replacement of a sewage lift station.

“We gladly support the efforts of our communities striving to promote the tremendous resources we have to attract jobs and a higher quality of life for our people,” said Governor Musgrove.

The funds are administered by the Mississippi Development Authority (MDA) through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program.
