Governor Musgrove Awards CAP Loan to Town of Glen

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove has awarded a \$50,000 Capital Improvements Revolving Loan Program (CAP) to the Town of Glen. The funds will be utilized to renovate a building for a fire station.

“Working with our communities and their leaders to ensure our first responders have the proper equipment and training they need in order to properly and safely perform their duties is a priority,” said Musgrove.

“Programs like the Capital Improvements Revolving Loan Program are crucial because they help our communities make needed infrastructure improvements,” said Musgrove. “We will continue to work together to build better communities and a better Mississippi.”

The funds are administered by the Mississippi Development Authority (MDA).

The CAP Loan program is a part of the Community Services Division of the Mississippi Development Authority. The Community Services Division also administers other Economic Development grant and loan programs.
