EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Policy IIB-1 is being revised to reflect the complete phasing out of the Functional Literacy Exam (FLE). The changes clarify when the last opportunity students have to take the FLE to meet graduation requirements and how the requirements can be met after the FLE is phased out.

Policy IIA-4 is no longer needed and it is being recommended for deletion.
