How to become a Two Mississippi Museums Volunteer

CURRENT MDAH Volunteers: If you are a current MDAH volunteer, you may sign up for the volunteer training. The training schedules are listed on the back and on the MDAH volunteer page.

NEW to MDAH Volunteering: In order to be placed in our volunteer system, you need to:

- Complete a volunteer application—online (preferred) or hard copy
- Attend a volunteer intake session which includes a brief overview of what volunteers will be doing and one-on-one chat/interview with a MDAH staff member
- If there is a match, you will be asked to complete intake paperwork and successfully complete volunteer orientation and training
