The Antiquities Law provides that publicly-owned properties found to have significance may be designated as Mississippi Landmarks by the Board of Trustees of the Mississippi Department of Archives and History. Designation recognizes the historical and/or architectural significance of the property and requires that proposed alterations that may affect the property's historic character be reviewed and approved by MDAH.

The Board of Trustees of the Mississippi Department of Archives and History invites public comment on the proposed designation of the aforementioned buildings as Mississippi Landmarks.
