Dear Governor Tuck:

Please find enclosed a check covering the hours you served as Governor from January 2000 through June 2000. As you know, the Acting Governor receives the difference between their salary and the Governor's. Below is the formula used to calculate an hourly rate for Acting Governor:

$24 \text{ hours/day} \times 366 \text{ days/year} = 8784 \text{ hours/year}$

| Lt. Governor's salary | = | <u>\$ 60,000</u> |
| Difference | = | \$ 41,800 |

Pay rate for Lt. Governor serving as Governor
 $\$41,800/8784 \text{ hours} = \$4.76/\text{hour}$

The records show that you served as Acting Governor for a total of 478.25 hours during January – June 2000. We calculated your gross salary amount as follows:

$478.25 \text{ hours} \times \$4.76/\text{hour} = \$2276.47$
