**ABERDEEN BASED COMPANY AWARDED PHASE B EARTHWORK  
CONTRACT FOR NISSAN**

JACKSON, Miss., January – Today, J.C. Burns, Executive Director, Mississippi Major Economic Impact Authority announced a Mississippi company has been awarded another site related contract for the Nissan project.

Eutaw Construction Company, Inc., based in Aberdeen, Mississippi was awarded a contract for approximately \$5 million for “Initial Earthwork –Phase B” which consists of constructing one-third of the building pad for the plant. The firm will begin construction of the pad immediately.

“Each day we continue to see progress being made, and truly appreciate the interest being shown by companies from Mississippi,” Mr. Burns said.

A total of six proposals were submitted for consideration of the contract.
