<u>Cultural Resources Specialist II, Archaeologist</u>

The Mississippi Department of Archives and History is recruiting a Cultural Resources Specialist II, archaeologist to serve in Historic Preservation. This position will have operational responsibility for monitoring the Winterville Mounds Restoration project, following the agency's role as the State Historic Preservation Office under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. Selected candidates will also be required to meet MDAH response needs to archaeological resources on privately owned lands when requested, including cataloging discoveries and assessing impacts on known sites. This position also serves the agency's role in identifying, registering, protecting, and distributing information about archaeological sites in Mississippi. This position is part of the archaeology section and reports to the archaeology section head/chief archaeologist. The primary duty station for this role is in Jackson, Mississippi. **This is a time-limited one-year term**.

Key Responsibilities:

- Monitor the daily construction activities at Winterville Mounds State Park, serving as an archaeological monitor and liaison with construction crews.
- Complete archaeological surveys and Phase II/III investigations following the Mississippi Standards for Archaeological Practice.
- Supervise additional personnel on archaeological projects as needed.
- Perform Laboratory Analysis on historic and prehistoric artifacts as necessary following survey work.
- Complete archaeological survey reports following Mississippi Standards for Archaeological Practice, including evaluating sites for significance according to the National Register Criteria for Eligibility.
- Assist in the management, cataloging, curation, and tracking archaeological site numbers, collections, and associated documentation throughout the state via GIS and database environments as needed.
- Document archaeological and historical resources using various media (including, but not limited to, photography, audio, film, mapping, forms, and hand-held instruments).
- Research requests and provide technical assistance to the public and agency for disseminating
 information of historical and archaeological significance through various media (including but
 not limited to reports, articles, letters, emails, and other written materials).
- Represent the agency through public speaking engagements, educational programs, and attendance at meetings related to the agency's mission.

Education and experience must meet the following criteria:

• A Bachelor's Degree and one year of related professional experience.
