		Initial estimates indicate that the total project cost is in the range of \$100 million to \$120 million. Budgets

		MDAH can provide the following project details: The state owns approximately 12.7 acres along the I-20 Frontage Road in Vicksburg, adjacent to the Vicksburg National Military Park (VNMP), where the new 63,500-square-foot interpretive center will be constructed. Museum exhibit galleries are being planned to occupy 16,000 square feet in the new building. The lobby will contain public-use areas such as a cafe, museum store, large multi-purpose room, and restrooms. The site will include a decked parking structure to hold 150 vehicles, oversized parking areas for buses and RVs, an event lawn, entry pathway, ravine overlook, meadow, and a separate staff parking and service area.
