The Mississippi Department of Archives and History is currently recruiting a part-time Bioarchaeologist to serve in the Historic Preservation division. This role is an integral part of the archaeology section and reports directly to the Senior Bioarchaeologist. The chosen candidate will be responsible for completing osteological assessments in accordance with agency responsibilities under the Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act. The Assistant Bioarchaeologist will also be responsible for completing weekly progress reports, preparing written reports documenting osteology collections and their provenance pursuant to MDAH NAGPRA procedures, and assisting in ensuring that osteology collections meet 36CFR79 Standards, including cleaning, cataloging, and rehousing of artifacts and ancestral remains. Successful candidates will have prior experience with documenting osteological collections.
